say, to open a channel of water communication from some point on the river Saint Clair to the waters of Lake Erie, at or near the Two Creeks in the Township of Romney, in the County of Kent aforesaid, so as to be navigable for vessels drawing twelve feet of water; otherwise this Act Or charter for-5 and every thing herein contained shall be null and void to all intents and feited. purposes.

XIV. Every vessel of whatsoever kind using the said Canal shall have Draft of water her draft of water legibly marked in figures not less than six inches long, to be marked from one foot to her greatest draft upon the stem and stern posts; and using the any wilful misstatement of such figures so as to mislead the officers of canal. the Canal as to any vessel's true draft, shall be punishable as a misde-meanor on the part of the owner and master of such a vessel, and the said Directors may detain any such a vessel upon which any incorrect figures of draft shall be found until the same are corrected at the expense 15 of her owner.

XV. XVI.
