An Act to repeal the Act of 1856, intituled, “ *An Act to extend the provisions of the Insolvent Debtors’ Act of Upper Canada, and for the relief of a certain class of persons therein mentioned.*”

WHEREAS it has been found that the Act passed in the Session of 1856, chapter 73, and intituled, “ *An Act to extend the provisions of the Insolvent Debtors’ Act of Upper Canada, and for the relief of a certain class of persons therein mentioned,*” has operated prejudicially to the mercantile interests of the Province, it is therefore expedient to repeal the same: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

I. The Act mentioned in the Preamble to this Act is hereby repealed.
