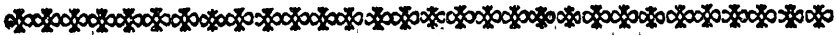

C A P. XLVI.

An Act for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of *Newfoundland*, and the Islands adjacent.



WHEREAS the better Administration of Justice in the Island of Newfoundland, and the Islands adjacent; be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for His Majesty, by His Commission under the Great Seal, to institute a Court of Criminal and Civil Jurisdiction, to be called, The Supreme Court of Judicature of the Island of Newfoundland, with full Power and Authority to hold Plea of all Crimes and Misdemeanors committed within the Island of Newfoundland, and on the Islands and Seas to which Ships or Vessels repair from the Island of Newfoundland, for carrying on the Fishery, and on

Preamble.

His Majesty, under the Great Seal, may institute a Court of Criminal and Civil Jurisdiction at Newfoundland, &c.
