
Sir,

In view of the report regarding the case of John Mukosoga he should ~~be~~ be given to understand that he must sell his horse and use the proceeds towards his support. If he fails to do this relief supplies should not be furnished to him.

A blanket will be sent from the Department for Mrs Catherine Keuoquom, the aged woman mentioned.
