



Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 25th Ultimo, stating that you had paid for Lot 19, Con. 2, Cockburn Island, and demanding the issue of Patent at once, I have to inform you that this Lot stands on the Books of the Department in the name of Sarah J. Reid, and is paid for in full, but before Patent can issue to you as requested, it will be necessary to furnish the Department, through the local Agent, Mr. Robert Thorburn, of Gore Bay, with an Assignment from Sarah J. It will also be necessary to furnish the usual Statutory proof of compliance with the conditions of sale, as regards occupation and improvement of the Lot, which should accompany your application to the Agent for Patent.
