A. The second time we made the arrest as far as I can remember there were only the 15 cwt and a jeep that had taken us there.
- Q. How did Brisson behave?
A. I cannot remember very well what he did all I can remember is that he attempted to resist us by holding on to the truck and also by wiggling.

- Q. Do you remember giving evidence on a Summary of Evidence?
A. Yes sir.
- Q. Do you remember stating there that when you arrested Pte Brisson at the second time at the road block there were three R 22 R officers there?
A. That might be I remembered better at that time.
- Q. When did you next see Brisson after he was brought back?
A. I saw him only the next morning.
- Q. How was he behaving the next morning?
A. The next morning I was in charge of the prisoners, my assistant asked Pte Brisson if he was coming down for breakfast and Pte Brisson answered, "No" and "I have a headache, I am not feeling well". Later on Pte Brisson told us what his waking up had been like, he told us that he was in a German Concentration Camp.
- Q. Did he say why he thought he was in a German Concentration Camp?
A. He didn't say why he only said that he thought he was in a German Concentration Camp, that he started to look around the place and that he was very pleased when he found out it was a Cdn Camp.
