TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE MINISTER OF RECONSTRUCTION

A. APPLICATIONS RECOMMENDED FOR APPROVAL

IT WAS RESOLVED

THAT the Minister of Reconstruction be advised that the Board of Governors of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation recommends that the following applications be granted for the reasons indicated.

(a) For Changes to Existing Stations:

<u>Station</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Request</u>
CJAV	Port Alberni, B.C.	Transfer of licence from "H.E. Warren" to "CJAV Ltd."
<u>Reason:</u> Mr. Warren will have a half interest in CJAV Ltd. The company is being formed to assist in financing operation of the station.		
CHAB	Moose Jaw, Sask.	Change in ownership and transfer of licence from "CHAB Ltd" to "a company to be formed".
<u>Reason:</u> The new company will be controlled on a fifty-fifty basis by William Lewers Davis, majority owner of the Prince Albert Daily Herald, and John Edgar Slight, part owner and manager of Moose Jaw Times Herald Ltd. The Board has followed a policy of recommending approval of transfer of licences to newspaper interests only in special circumstances. It believes that there are special circumstances in this case in that the present owner has been endeavouring to sell the station for some time and there appear not to have been other suitable prospective purchasers interested. Mr. Slight and Mr. Davis have given assurance that the station will be operated as a separate entity from the local newspaper and will carry on, with possible improvements, the present policies.		
CHOV	Pembroke, Ont.	1. Transfer of licence from "D.A. Jones" to "Ottawa Valley Broadcasting Co. Ltd." 2. Transfer of 185 shares in Ottawa Valley Broadcasting Co. Ltd. from "D.A. Jones" to "a new company to be formed, probably called "Ottawa Valley Development Co. Ltd."."
