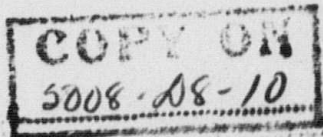
1. Enclosed herewith Certificates of Registration and Airworthiness Nos. 10169 and 2015 respectively surrendered for cancellation.
