Containing by admeasure. - ment four acres and seventeen hundredths of an acre, be the same according to the surey and plan thereof, made by Lewis Burwell Esquire, Deputy Surveyor, and is butted and bounded as follows, that is to day, commencing where a post has been planted on the North side of the Grand River, on the East side of the Road, leading to Namelton, then Easterly along the Bank or margin of the Grand Oliver, about four chains, and forty three links, more or less, to where a jost has been planted, also on the North Bank or margin of the Grand River, at the Southerly angle of the said track of Land.
