

7 CHRISTIAN EVIDENCES AND COMPARATIVE RELIGION—

(One hour a week throughout the four terms).

This course will embrace a study of the questions of the reliability of God's revelation, fulfilled Prophecy, the Character of Christ, Miracles, the effects of Christianity, etc. Its aim will be to give a solid ground for the beliefs of Orthodox Christianity. It will also take up a study of the great non-Christian religions.

8 MISSIONS:—

(One hour a week throughout the four terms).

This will not be properly a course of study, but is designed to bring to the students, messages from Home and Foreign Missionaries, so as to widen their outlook and sympathies and keep in touch with the preaching of the gospel in all lands.

9 GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY OF BIBLE LANDS—

(One hour a week for two terms).

There is so much light thrown on the Scriptures by a knowledge of the lands of the East, and of their History, that this course aims at furnishing a useful side-light on Bible Study.

10 PRACTICAL CHRISTIAN WORK—

(One hour a week throughout the four terms).

The reason for the very existence of the Bible Training School is the training of Christian WORKERS. Class work in Personal Work, conducting meetings, visiting, etc., will be supplemented by the actual practice of the instruction given.

11 HOMILETICS—

(One hour a week for two terms).

Students taking this course will be required to study both the theory and the practice of the composition and delivery of addresses.
