

The meetings in March, June, September and December shall be the quarterly meetings, and the last of these the Annual General Meeting.

Sec. 2. Seven members shall constitute a quorum at all meetings.

Sec. 3. The President, or in her absence the Vice-President, may call a special meeting of the Society for urgent business, or at the written request of four members. Notices of such special meetings shall state the business for which the meeting is called and no other business may be transacted.

ARTICLE XI.

Motions and Reports.

Sec. 1. At regular or special meetings of the Society any member making a motion shall, upon the request of the President, put the same in writing, and it shall be read by the Secretary and seconded before discussion. Reports of committees shall be in writing and shall be signed by the President of said committee; also all notices of motion.

Sec. 2. No person shall speak more than once upon any subject, except the person proposing a resolution, who shall have the right to reply and close the debate. The President shall de-
