CONSTITUTION

OF THE

CATHOLIC TRUTH SOCIETY OF OTTAWA.

I. The Society shall be called the "Catholic Truth Society of Ottawa."

OBJECTS.

2. The objects of the Society shall be :---

- (I) To disseminate among Catholics small and cheap devotional works.
- (2) To assist the uneducated poor to a better knowledge of their . religion.
- (3) To spread among Protestants information about Catholic Truth.
- (4) To promote the circulation of good, cheap and popular Catholic books.

3. The Society shall be conducted as a branch of "The Catholic Truth Society" of England.

OFFICERS.

4. The Society may elect one or more patrons.

5. The officers of the Society shall consist of a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer and an Executive Committee of ten, who shall be elected by ballot, separately in the above mentioned order at the annual general meeting of the Society, and who shall constitute a committee for the government and management of the affairs of the Society, for the furthering of its ends and the carrying out of its objects.

6. In the event of a vacancy occuring in this Committee, the remaining members thereof shall have power to fill such vacancy.

COMMITTEE.

7. The Committee, of which five shall form a quorum, shall have charge of and control all the affairs of the Society, and shall decide all questions that arise affecting the interests, objects or work of the Society.

8. The Committee shall have control of the funds of the Society, and shall cause to be prepared annually a detailed statement of the condition
