Dominion Rifle Association, to be registered by him one month previous to the Match."

Clause 8 to be amended so as to read as follows:

"8.—There shall be a Council of Fifty-two Members, who shall be elected in the following proportions:—

Sixteen [16] from Ontario.
Twelve [12] "Quebec.
Seven [7] from New Brnnswick.

Seven [7] from Nova Scotia. Five [5] from Manitoba. Five [5] "British Columbia.

Clause 15 to be amended so as to read as follows:

"15.—The Annual Prize Meetings shall be held at Ottawa, at such times as may be determined on by the Council."
