to make good sticking plaster, put two spoonfuls of baisam of Peru to six of isinglass, melted with very little water and strained. Mix these well together in a small stone jar over the fire. Pin out some black Persian or sarsenet on a board, and dipping a brush into the mixture, pass it over the silk five or six times, then hold it to the fire, but not very near, and it will soon become black and shining.

For dyspepsia, pour one quart of cold water on two tablespoonfuls of unslacked lime; let stand a few minutes, bottle and cork, and when clear it is ready for use; put three tablespoonfuls in a cup of milk, and drink any time, usually before meals.




