and required to proceed for the recovery thereof in the like manner as is provided by the twentieth section of the herein before recited Act: Provided always, that no person not being a British Subject. shall be liable to pay in any one year during his residence in this Province, more than the faid fum of forty shillings.

All fines and fums of paid to the Quarter-Maicontingencies.

XIII. And be it further enacted, That all fines, penalties and fums of money received, to be money whatsoever, received, or which shall hereaster be received, under ters of Battalions, who and by virtue of the provisions of this Act and the herein before rethall account every fix cited Act, shall be paid into the hands of the Quarter-Masters of the mouths to the Commandmonths to the Commanding Officer of the Batta- different Battalions; and the Quarter-Master of each Battalion shall lion, and pay the amount every fix months render an account of all fuch fines, penalties, and ry, subject to appropriations by order of the Battalion, and forthwith pay the amount thereof into the Pro-Commander in Chief for into the Province Treasus fums of money, so by him received, to the Commanding Officer of vince Treasury, rendering therewith an account of the same; subject nevertheless to such appropriations as the Commander in Chief shall from time to time direct for the contingent uses of the respective Battalions.

Limitation.

XIV. And be it further enacted, That the faid herein before recited Act, except wherein it is hereby altered, together with this Act, shall continue in force for two years, or until the end of the next Seffion of the General Assembly.

Sums to be paid out of the Treasury.

BE it enacted by the Prefident, Council and Affembly, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the Province, unto the feveral Persons hereaster mentioned, the sollowing sums, to wit :-

To the Speaker.

To the Speaker of the House of Assembly, the sum of fifty pounds.

Members of the Affem-

To the Members of the House of Assembly for defraying the expences of their attendance during the present Session, and for travelling charges, reckoning twenty miles for each day's travel, to be certified by the Speaker, ten shillings per diem.

Chaplain of the Council.

To the Chaplain of the Council in General Assembly, the sum of twenty pounds.

Chaplain of the House of Affembly.

To the Chaplain of the House of Assembly, the sum of twenty pounds, and a further fum of five pounds for travelling charges.

Clerk of the Council.

To the Clerk of the Council in General Assembly, the sum of fifty pounds, and the fum of twenty shillings per diem during the present Seffion.

Clerk of the Assembly.

To the Clerk of the House of Assembly, the sum of fifty pounds, and twenty shillings per diem during the present Session.

Serjeant at Arms to the Council.

To the Serieant at Arms attending the Council in General Assembly, sisteen shillings per diem during the present Session. · To
