THIRD SESSION OF THE TWENTIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

THURSDAY, 26th February, 1857.

THE General Assembly having been, by Proclamation, prorogued to this day, the Legislative Council met.

Mr. President acquainted the House, that His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor had provisionally appointed William Forgan, Esquire, by Warrant, bearing date the Twenty-ninth day of November, 1856, a Member of this House, who desires to be admitted.

Ordered, That Mr. Dingwell and Mr. Beaton be a Committee to attend Mr. Forgan. and see him qualified.

Mr. Dingwell, from the Committee appointed to attend Mr. Forgan, and see him qualified, reported, that they had, according to order, attended Mr. Forgan, who took the Oaths in the presence of the Lieutenant Governor.

The Honorable Mr. Forgan was then introduced between Mr. Dingwell and Mr. Beaton, and took his seat.
