1—All coal carried or wheeled be charged one cent per cwt. 2—All coal carried up or down steps, two cents per cwt.

3—All coal carried up two flights of steps, three cents per cwt. 4—All coal, 500 lbs. or under, carried, five cents.

5—All high sidewalks or curbs to be bridged, gates open, and snow shovelled in Winter, or to be charged as carried.

6—All cellar windows that cannot be hooked up, breakage at owner's risk. 7—These charges to be paid on delivery, or persons not being at home, to leave money at Coal Office...

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS. THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$5.00 per acre. Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 60 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent is on certain conditions.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead rights may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate 60 acres and erect a house worth \$500. The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rocks, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.
