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On a Bad Trait in Singing.

To send a copy of this resolution to the Halifax Morning Chronicle and to such other papers as they may deem advisable for publication.

To communicate with the Local members for Lunenburg County to secure their assistance.

To take all possible steps to secure a return to the former rates and time.

To report progress to the Council of Mahone Bay Board of Trade from time to time.
