Steamer on Fire! Special to the Evening Telegram. A wireless from St. John's stated that a message received from the North German Lloyd's liner 'Sevdyg' Capt. Deyers, bound for New York, stated that they passed a large steamer on fire with apparently no one on board, about 150 miles S.E. of St. John's, but could not ascertain the name of the vessel, which had apparently been burning two or three days.
