

Opening of the Present London Bridge.

opening of the present London bridge
On August 1, 1881, the anniversary of the House of Hanover, King William IV. and Queen Adelaide went by water from Somerset House, with their retinues, in their State barges, to witness the opening of the new London Bridge. The Lord Mayor and Corporation made extraordinary efforts for their entertainment, among which was the ascent in his balloon by the “Intrepid aeronaut,” Mr. Green. The king ascended the long flight of steps from the water without any appearance of fatigue, and received an enthusiastic meeting from the countless multitude that witnessed the scene. The keys of the City having been presented by the Lord Mayor, and graciously returned, the Royal party proceeded to a pavilion that had been erected for their accommodation, where, after having inspected the bridge, they returned and partook of a splendid banquet provided by the Corporation. Many members of the Royal family were present, including the Duchesses of Gloucester, Cambridge, and Cumberland, the Duke of Sussex, Prince George of Cumberland, and Prince George of Cambridge. The Lord Mayor was permitted to propose the King's health, and Sir Claudius Hunter that of the Queen, His Majesty then, out of a gold cup, drank to the trade and commerce of the City of London, after which the loving cup went round among the members of the Royal family. Finally, the King proposed the health of the Lord Mayor and Lady Mayoress, after which the Royal party returned to their barges to Somerset House, followed by the State barges of the Lord Mayor and the City Companies, gorgeously decorated, while the multitudes along the banks hailed the spectacle with acclamation. The King enjoyed the demonstrations exceedingly, and as a proof of his satisfaction the Lord Mayor—Key—was the next day created a baronet.

Unsolved Mystery.

Body of Woman Found in Trunk.

NEW YORK, July 24.—The mystery surrounding the death of the unidentified young woman whose mutilated body was found recently in a trunk at the American Railway Express Company warehouse here, has been shifted to Detroit authorities for solution. Captain Arthur Carey, head of the New York homicide Bureau, announced to-day:

Removal of every vital organ save the brain from the body makes it virtually impossible to determine the cause of death. Medical Examiner Schwartz announced:

“The cutting was perhaps the work of a butcher,” he said, “or some one slightly acquainted with surgery.”

“A large bladed knife similar to the type used by physicians in performing an autopsy and a saw were used. The cutting was done by a pathological student.”

Dr. Schwartz expressed the opinion that the solution of the mystery must come from Detroit.

The police theory is that the mutilation was the work of a maniac possessing a crude knowledge of medicine, but none of surgery.

“Whoever did the job,” said Chief Medical Examiner Norris, “knew enough to remove all organs which would give evidence of a crime or method of death.”

“I am almost certain that a criminal operation was performed,” he added: “that can be determined by finding traces of chloroform in the brain.”

New York, July 24.—Unset diamonds said to be worth \$50,000 were seized by Custom Officers here yesterday when a sailor of the steamship Stockholm attempted to smuggle them ashore. He had secreted the jewels in his clothing.

The sailor said that he did not know personally who had given him the diamonds. They had been delivered to him before sailing for the United States, he asserted, by unidentified persons and he did not know to whom they were to be delivered. Because of his unsatisfactory explanation, he was taken into custody by the Custom Officers.

White Cannibals.

Among the remarkable adventures of Dr. A. H. Rice, who has returned after exploring the upper reaches of the Amazon and its tributaries, was a meeting with white cannibals, seven feet in height.

Accompanied by a number of natives, Dr. Rice set forth in a single canoe to map the Upper Orinoco. While they were engaged on their work one of the natives saw a gigantic white savage, stark naked, making his way through the under-bush. The natives explained that he was one of the “legendary white Indians,” whose ferocity had made them a terror to their dark-hued neighbours for centuries.

Several shots were fired in the direction of the savage, and instantly the jungle seemed alive with his companions.

Every one was between six and seven feet in height. They were armed with spears, bows and arrows, and blow-pipes, and Dr. Rice recognized them as the mountain cannibals who are regarded as the most ferocious in Brazil, Venezuela, and Colombia. They have been seen only once before by a white explorer, when Ensign Boadilla, during explorations on behalf of the Spanish Government, found them in 1763.

Britain Refuses Money Grants.

London, July 22.—(By Percy Sarl, United Press).—The British government to-day fired the first shot in the battle between itself and those rebel county councils of Ireland, which, by a tremendous majority, refused to deal with the British authorities to which they are subordinate.

The situation which has arisen was forecast by the United Press more than a month ago. Sinn Fein had not attempted to conceal its purpose in backing the election of its own men to the county councils. Once in these local legislative bodies, what could be simpler than to refuse to levy the usual taxes, refuse to make assessments, hold up all financial bills, and otherwise wreck the entire fiscal system of the counties controlled by the rebels? That is what has happened.

The British government on the other hand, has one weapon at its command. It can refuse to make money grants to any county in which Sinn Fein controls the government. And the announcement that this is just what the Britishers propose to do was made in definite form for the first time to-day.

“Those county councils,” it was said in the House of Commons, “which continue to defy or ignore the British Government, will be refused any money grants whatsoever.”

In making this announcement, Sir Hamar Greenwood, Secretary for Ireland, revealed the fact that Great Britain had decided to sever financial relations with nearly three-fourths of Ireland, unless a change of attitude

is an once apparent in the recalcitrant councils.

Dublin was practically isolated as far as railway traffic was concerned to-day, through the action of the military authorities, who placed several soldiers on every train scheduled to leave the Kingsbridge terminus.

According to their custom, the railwaymen promptly refused to move the trains, while the military were aboard, whereupon the progress of the coaches was halted.
