Earned \$176 a Share of Common in First Six Months of Fiscal Year.

NEW YORK, Dec. 14.—American Car & Foundry for six months ended October 31, 1925, reports net income of \$2,107,918 after taxes and charges. This is first six months' statement issued and the company hereafter will publish semi-annual earnings statements.

American Car & Foundry net income of \$2,107,918 for the first six months of its fiscal year is equal, after 7 per cent. preferred dividends, to \$176 a share on 600,000 no-par common shares.
