

Traffic at the Guelph Station of the G. W. R.

Some time ago we mentioned that the traffic at the Guelph Station on this road for the months ending November, 1872, showing an increase of over 80 per cent as compared with the same period in 1871. We have seen a statement for three months ending December, 1872, compared with the same period in 1869—when this was the terminus of the line—which shows an increase of 80 per cent. in "received" traffic, and a decrease of only 15 per cent. in the "forwarded" traffic. These figures show that notwithstanding the evil forebodings of not a few, Guelph has not suffered by the extension of the line beyond this point, in fact the slight decrease in "forwarded" business is owing entirely to the drought which caused a poor harvest, and a lack of water in the mills, as the great bulk of this traffic in 1869 was in flour, of which, of course, but very little was manufactured last fall.


