THE GRANGERS ARE STRONG

Another large decrease in Canadian Pacific earnings. Good Demand for Commercial Cable-Coal Stocks Unsettled at New York-Wheat in Chicago the Lowest on Record-Cables Closed Weak-Increase in Visible and Increase Abroad to Europe.

Monday Evening, Feb. 18. Earnings of C.P.R. for second week of Feb. were only \$224,000, a decrease of \$62,000 as compared with same week of last year.

The English visible supply of wheat decreased 85,000 bushels the past week. During the past four weeks a visible supply of wheat in Canada and the U.S. decreased 4,353,000 bushels as compared with 1,539,000 bushels during the same period of last year.

There was deposited to-day at sub-treasurer \$1,800,000 in gold on syndicate account. The Senate committee will report favorably 3 per cent. loan certificates.

Wheat was demoralized in the early trading at Chicago this morning, the May option selling at \$1 7/8 to \$2, the lowest on record. The large decrease in the visible supply was recently offset by the increase in passage to Europe.
