Peach Trees Sprayed with Whitewash for Winter Protection.

Peach buds are induced to swell during warm spells in winter and early spring, such as have prevailed this season. Whitewashing prevents this as whitened buds reflect heat rather than absorb it. The illustration shows a portion of the orchard of W. M. Orr & Son, of Fruitland, Ontario, protected in this way.
