Some years ago the great Monte Cristo company commenced work on the Mystery and Pride of the Mountains on a wonderful surfac, showing of low grade ore. Thoy steadily developed the property, built a concentrator and put in power drills. Many people said the ore was too base or too low grade to work, but the company kept right on driving tunnels and taking out ore. And to-day, when depth has been gained on the property, the ore has changed to a comparatively high grade proposition and the success of the venture is assured.

Two years ago-even a year sincethere was some question of the ledges in this section, whether the values held their own with depth. There is no longer any doubt about that. Everywhere that depth has been gained, values have increased. It may not be that all ledges will do so, but thus far none has failed .- Miner.
