Toyo Eiwa Jo Gakko—Attendance for January, 60; Feb raary, 68; March, 67. Of these twenty eight are supported girls, two are the children of the servants. One girl taken on trial in October was dropped in January. Tomono Sada entered on trial in January. The school pays for her board and tuition; a former pupil of the school helps her with her other expenses. She is recommended to be taken on as aregular pupil.
