- 1. The milk must be kept scrupulously clean in
every respect.
2. No milk to be brought to the factory from
cows whose calves have not been dropped at least
three days.

men, that bran greatly promotes the milk secretions
in cows, and it is fed almost universally, about
equally mixed with corn meal is the usual propor-
tion. This mixture seems to promote both quanti-
ty and quality of milk."

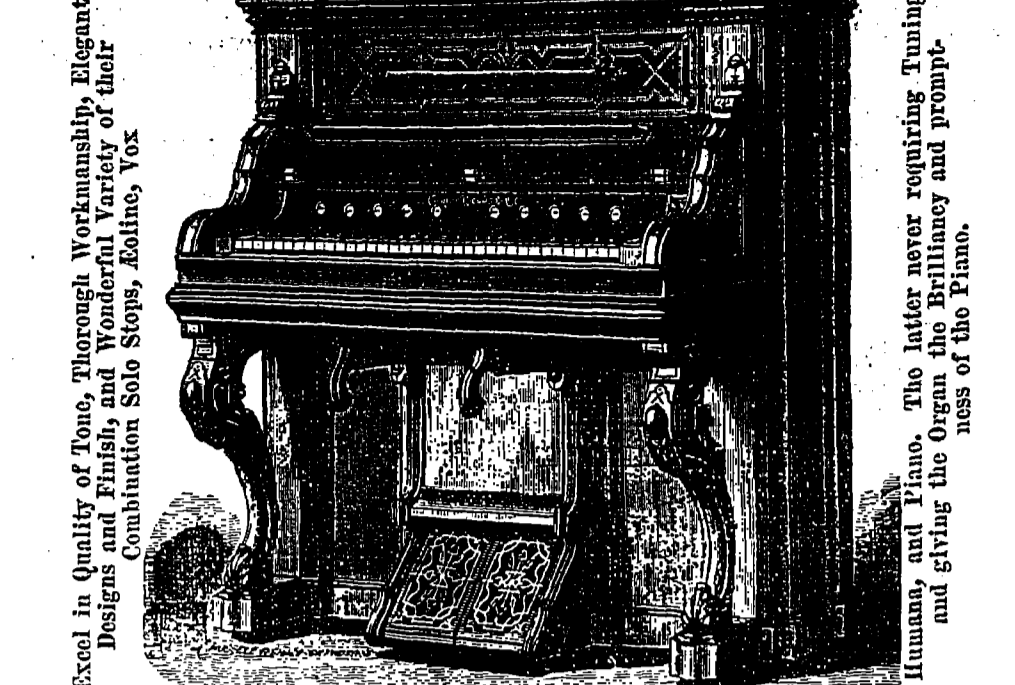

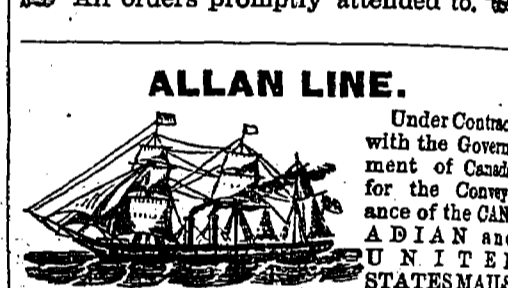
