## Vancouver Board of Trade

An article that will throw strong light upon the commercial history of the city is the chronicle of the VANCOUVER Board of Trade, which was organized in 1887, and that of the Vancouver Tourist Association, both of which have done splendid and effectual work in the building-up of the city. The evolution of the Fire Department, the Police Department, and of the machinery of city government will be told in detail. The stepping-up of these departments from their early primitive state to an absolutely up-to-date modernity is of absorbing interest.
