ADDITIONAL TO THAT AGREEMENT, SIGNED IN BRUSSELS ON JANUARY 24, 1951.

Les Gouvernements signataires du présent Protocole

The Governments Parties to the Present Protocol, Desiring to insure the coming into force of the Agreement Relating to the Abolition of Discriminating Claims to German Enemy Assets, opened for signature at Brussels, December 8, 1947, hereafter called the Brussels Agreement, and to this effect to extend from September 1, 1948 to September 1, 1951 the stipulations in the first paragraph of Article 3 of the aforesaid Brussels Agreement, and likewise desiring to this effect to extend from September 1, 1951 to September 1, 1951 the time stipulated in the second Protocol, signed in Brussels, on May 10, 1950 additional to the Brussels Agreement,

Have agreed as follows: The date September 1, 1951 shall be considered as replacing the date September 1, 1948 whenever the latter date appears in the second Protocol signed in Brussels, on May 10, 1950, additional to the aforesaid Brussels Agreement, and the said Protocol shall be considered as replaced by this present Protocol.

In witness whereof the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed the present Protocol. Done in Brussels on January 24, 1951, in the English and French languages, two texts being equally authentic, in a single original which shall be deposited in the Archives of the Government of Belgium. (Here follow the names of signatories for Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, and the United States of America.)
