

CANADA'S VOTING RECORD IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The 33rd regular session of the General Assembly of the United Nations opened on 24 September 1978. There were 113 resolutions or parts of resolutions adopted by the Assembly. Of these recorded votes, Canada voted in favour of 73 (approximately 65 per cent), against 19 (17 per cent) and abstained on 21 (18 per cent).
