REINSTATEMENT OF DEMOCRACY IN HAITI

HAVING SEEN:

Resolutions MRE/RES. 1/91, MRE/RES. 2/91 and MRE/RES. 3/92 of the Ad Hoc Meeting of Ministers of Foreign Affairs;

The Protocol of Washington of February 23, 1992;

Permanent Council resolution CP/RES. 594 (923/92), and resolutions 46/7, 46/138 and 47/20 of the United Nations General Assembly;

HAVING HEARD the report of the Secretary General on the situation in Haiti:

PERSUADED that a return to the framework of democratic institutions is necessary for Haiti's political, economic and social development;

DEEPLY ALARMED at the persisting serious violations of human rights in Haiti and the worsening situation with respect thereto:

FULLY AWARE of the reparcusaions of the increase in the number of Haitians seeking refuge in neighboring member countries; and

CONVINCED that further efforts are necessary to achieve the objectives set forth in the aforecited resolutions.

RESOLVES:

- 1. To reaffire resolutions MRE/RES. 1/91, MRE/RES. 2/91 and MRE/RES. 3/92 of the Ad Hoc Meeting of Ministers of Foreign Affairs.
- 2. To urge the member states of the Organization of American States and the United Nations which have not yet done so to take the necessary steps internally, as a matter of urgency, to fully implement the measures
