Mr. Paul St. Pierre, M.P., Parliamentary Secretary to the Secretary of State for External Affairs. Mr. St. Pierre was elected Member of Parliament for Coast-Chilcotin, British Columbia in 1968. Before this, he was a newspaper reporter, columnist and editor, and he is the author of numerous television plays, stage plays and books. In the House of Commons, he is on the Committee of Procedures and Organization, and the Committee for External Affairs and National Defence. Since 1968 he has held such positions as Vice-Chairman of the House of Commons Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development, Rapporteur of the Scientific and Technical Committee of the North Atlantic Parliamentary Assembly and Head of the Canadian Observer Group at the Organization of American States. In 1971, he was a member of the Canadian Delegation to the United Nations General Assembly, and prior to that was appointed Parliamentary Secretary to the Secretary of State for External Affairs.
