PRAYERS.

Mr. Hopkins, from the Standing Committee on National Resources and Public Works, presented the Fifth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Wednesday, January 21, 1970, your Committee has considered Bill C-144, "An Act to provide for the management of the water resources of Canada including research and the planning and implementation of programs relating to the conservation, development and utilization of water resources", and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 2

Strike out line 7 on page 3 and substitute therefor the following:

"significantly affect the quantity or quality of water outside such"

Add immediately after subclause (2) on page 4 the following new subclause:

(3) This Act is binding on Her Majesty in right of Canada or a province and any agent thereof.

Insert after new subclause (3) the following:

"PART I"**Clause 4**

Delète line 39, on page 5, and substitute therefor the following:

"account views expressed at public hearings and otherwise, by"
