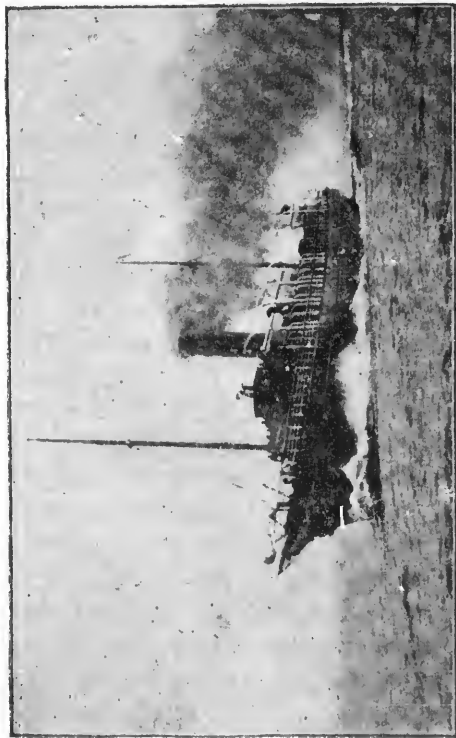




### R. M. S. BRUCE.

Fast powerful boat connecting St. John's, Nfld., with Canada by the Reid railway system, Port Aux Basque and North Sydney. The Bruce was the first to make semi-weekly trips from Newfoundland to North Sydney throughout the entire winter, and is said to be the first link of the Reid European Air Line over Newfoundland (per chart opp. page 12) —the Shortest Atlantic Route.
