penalties, and forfeitures shall be applied and appropriated towards defraying the expence of carrying this act into execution.

Limitation of actions.

Treble cofts.

No officer of the cuftoms capable of acting as a juftice.

Continuance of this act.

16. And be it further enacted, That if any action or fuit shall be brought or commenced against any perfon for any thing done in purfuance of this act, fuch action or fuit shall be commenced within fix months next after the matter or thing. done; and the defendant in fuch fuit or General iffue. action may plead the general iffue, and give this act and the fpecial matter in evidence at any trial to be had thereupon; and if a verdict shall pass for the defendant, or the plaintiff shall be nonfuited, or difcontinue his action after the defendant has appeared, or if judgement shall be given. upon any verdict or demurrer, against the plaintiff, the defendant shall recover treble cofts, and have the like remedy for the fame as defendants have in other cafes by law.

> 17. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That no officer whatever, being in the fervice of his Majesty's cuftoms in the ifland of Newfoundland, fhall be capable of acting as a justice of the peace in and for the faid ifland.

18. And be it further enacted, That this act shall continue in force until the tenth day of June one thousand feven hundred and ninety-three, and from thence to the end of the then next feffion of Parliament.
