An Act to amend *The Criminal Code*, 1892, as respects Lotteries.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

**1.** Subsection 6 of section 205 of *The Criminal Code*, 1892, 1892, c. 29, 5 as the said subsection is enacted by section 2 of chapter 42 of s. 205, ss. 6, and 1901, c. the statutes of 1901, is hereby amended by adding thereto the 42, s. 2, following as paragraph (c.) thereof:—
