MAKE VICTORIA YOUR PIVOTAL POINT for sight-seeing. The surrounding attractions of Victoria will keep the visitor fully interested for days. A suggested few of the local and nearby points of interest and drives are:—

DRIVES: Ocean Beaches, Gordon Head, Douglas Park, Cordova Bay, Dominion Government Observatory Butchart's Sunken Gardens, Brentwood, Saanich Peninsula Drive, Deep Cove, etc., Colwood, Metchosin and Sooke Drive, Malahat Drive and Shawnigan Lake.

OCEAN BEACHES: Fowl Bay, Shoal Bay, Oak Bay, Willows Beach, Cadboro Bay, Cordova Bay, the Gorge Bathing Beach.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS: The Gorge Park Beacon Hill Park, Natural History Museum, Provincial Library, Meteorological Observatory. Esquimalt Harbor, with one of the largest drydocks in the world now under construction, Marine Drive and residential section, House of Parliament, etc.
