Ceremony, Sept. 14.

The Toronto Presbytery held its regular meeting yesterday in Knox Church.

Rev. J. A. McLean was received by certificate from the Presbytery of St. John's.

It was announced that a special meeting had been called for the 14th inst., at 3 p.m., in St. Andrew's Church.

The Rev. Armstrong Black, the moderator will preside; Rev. J. B. O'Neil, Moderator of the Presbytery, will deliver the charge to the minister, and the Rev. Prof. Ballantyne will address the people.

In the evening a public reception will be held, to which all the members of the Presbytery have been invited.

A resolution, expressing regret at the resignation of the Rev. C. H. Hossack, and a hope that a season of rest might fit him to resume the work of the ministry, was unanimously adopted by the Presbytery.

Dr. S. R. MacClements, minister of Chalmers' Church, asked that he be released from his charge, in order that he might accept a call from Rutherford, N.J.

Dr. MacClements is now in Ireland, and cannot obtain passage earlier than Sept. 20, his congregation having adjourned.

The warmest affection for him, decided not to oppose the resignation.

Dr. R. P. Mackay was appointed moderator of the session during the vacancy.

Mr. T. R. Holliday, one of this year's graduates of Knox, was licensed to preach.

The Presbytery stands adjourned until called by the moderator and clerk when they are communicated with the agent of the twentieth century fund.
