KEEPING DOWN OF DUST

Is Just Now An Important Topic With
the Residents Along the
Beach Road.

CITY COUNCIL ASKED FOR HELP

Conference Reached in Nothing—
Social to Rev. W. F. Wilson—
General City News.

Hamilton, June 21.—(Special.)—The main topic of discussion at the meeting of the Beach Road and Beach Committee this evening was the watering of the Beach roads.

Councillors Dewar and Carscallen of the St. Lawrence Council waited on the aldermen, and asked for assistance in laying the dust at the beach road. They said that the only plan that was practical was to have about six cisterns, costing \$100 each, and the regular wagon, etc., to cost \$600 more.

The Township Council asked the city to give an annual grant towards the expense. After some talk Ald. Reid moved that a grant of \$250 be made, but this was voted down as being too extravagant. The chairman, Ald. Waddell, said he was willing to give \$100, but the township representatives said that would be of no use. Nothing was done in the matter. The outcome of a meeting of Beach residents next Tuesday to consider this and other matters will be awaited with interest.

R.C.Y.C.'s Saturday Program—Commodore Gooderham Measures the Invader.

Commodore Gooderham will not start the Invader at Hamilton for the Queen's Cup on Dominion Day. As already stated in The World, the Hamilton Yacht Club looked to be playing cannon, but not this time. The Invader will be in Toronto on July 3.

President Landers-Green and his friends are to settle on the conditions of the trial race for the Queen's Cup. The Invader will not turn up, nothing was made known, but it is a settled thing that the Invader will be the same as in 1899, viz., three days over a distance of 21 miles and one to windward and return, nine miles out.
