#### CANDIDATES FOR THE MINISTRY.

The following regulations of Conference are prescribed for Students in training for the Ministry of the Methodist Church of Canada.

On presenting themselves for reception on trial, candidates will be examined as follows:—

English Grammar and Composition.

Arithmetic.

Geography.

Ancient History, (Schmitz.)

Modern History, (Collier's British Empire.)

New Testament History, (Smith.)

Theology, (Wesley's Sermons I. to LII.)

Graduates and Undergraduates in Arts will be examined only in Biblical History and Wesley's Sermons.

Students appointed by Conference to attend College, not being graduates or undergraduates in Arts, will, at the end of the first year, be examined in the following subjects:—

Theology, Introductory Lectures.

Church History to the Reformation.
