NEW DIAMOND FIELDS

Germans Determined to Monopolize Output

(New York Sun.)

Maiden Lane importers have received definite reports on the new diamond fields in the German colonies of South Africa, about which there have been conflicting statements. Henry W. Diederich, the American consul-general at Antwerp, where most of the diamonds from the new fields are being cut, prepared the report especially.

Mr. Diederich says that in the last year the German government has established law and order and that the German people after sacrificing many lives now have a chance of getting back at least the money which they have expended in the development of the colony, an amount exceeding \$30,000,000. The consular general writes that the Germans are determined to monopolize the output of the new mines and also gradually to build up an entire diamond industry of their own, from the delivery of rough stones to supplying the finished product to the market.

At first a syndicate composed of the leading banks in Berlin took charge of the output, but the temporary arrangement soon gave way to a contract with the German government made with the syndicate, Kryn, Coetmans & Wall, who are Germans, but have their cutting factories in Antwerp and New York. To this syndicate the government granted a monopoly of the new diamond fields and in return is to get 80 per cent. of the profits.

Special attention is given in the report to the question as to the average size of the diamonds found in the German colonies, because this has been the most doubtful point to the new diamond fields. While a few large stones have been found ranging in weight from five to seven carats, Mr. Diederich says that the average weight thus far seems to be about one-third of a carat. Stones of one carat, he adds, are not rare.

DANCING IN SCHOOLS

Professors Talk of Value as Physical Training

London, Aug. 20.—An address on gymnastic work was given by Franklin Wilkie, of the Chelsea Polytechnic, at the women's congress at the Japan-British exhibition. Physical training for girls, he urged, should comprise games, dancing and games, and should be given only by trained teachers. She believed that anaemia and hysteria in girls were due largely to lack of physical training. Such exercises should be taken for twenty minutes every day. The time now given in schools was not sufficient. In Germany, Sweden, and Denmark, suitable shoes were provided for children during exercises by the school. (Laughter.)

After a display of drill and dancing by girls, Mr. Cecil Sharp spoke on the subject of dancing, saying that educationists were agreed as to the desirability of introducing it into the schools. He held that dancing was an art of great educational value. It was necessary to introduce into the schools some subject to nourish the imaginative faculties, because are dealt with feeling. True dancing was an artistic expression of an inward idea, which all the limbs took a share in expressing. The teaching of dancing should be said, begin with folk dancing.

The objection to dancing made by certain people was dismissed by the fact that Morris dances were performed by persons all of the same sex. The Morris dance was one of the whole body, and in that lay its value as physical exercise.

KING OF COCOS

ISLAND IS DEAD

George Clunies Ross, Third of English Family to Rule Malaya

The death of George Clunies Ross, King of the Cocos Islands is reported by cable from Ventnor, Eng., where he had been in search of health.

The Cocos Islands, over which the Ross family has reigned for more than 80 years are situated about 700 miles from Java and are under British protection. It was here that Darwin studied the formation of coral reefs, and at the time of his visit in 1827, the first of the Ross family, John Clunies Ross, a Scottishman and an English naval officer, took up his residence there. His son took up the rule in 1871 at the age of 31.

When a young man George Clunies Ross studied engineering in Glasgow, returning to the islands in 1866. He had a large family. Mr. Ross's grandmother was a Malay. He himself married a Eurasian. There are no white women on the islands.

Coincidentally, the death of George Ross, the carrier "Jing" are the sole medium of exchange. Crime hardly exists and, without police or military, perfect order prevails.

Mr. Ross had the power of life and death over 600 or 700 subjects. On the islands rats climb trees and nibble the coconuts, the giant land crab scuttles to and fro, cutting with its pincers the wood

The Useful Sunflower

Sunflowers grown in America usually go to waste, but in Russia the seeds of the plant are quite useful. In that country the seeds are eaten in immense quantities. They are sometimes eaten raw, and on some occasions roasted in much the same manner as our peanuts.

One of the important articles of diet is the oil squeezed from the sunflower. It is claimed that the oil from the sunflower is a great deal like olive oil, and on account of the great number of religious fast days in Russia the seeds take the place of meat on the table. The stalks and leaves of the sunflower are highly prized for fuel, being a substitute for wood. An acre of sunflowers will give many cords of good fuel.

At one time purified sunflower oil was used to quite an extent in adulterating olive oil. It is a pale yellowish color and highly palatable. In the crude state it is used by painters to some extent, but it is inferior to linseed oil.

In China the fibre from the sunflower stalks is woven into beautiful fabrics, and it is thought that with the use of the proper machinery sunflowers might be grown in this country at a profit.

BIG INCREASE IN

WORLD'S SHIPPING

Great Increase in Steam Tonnage and Remarkable Decrease in Sailing Tonnage in Past 25 Years

The statistical tables published in the new edition of Lloyd's Register Book furnish most interesting matter. It appears from these tables that the total tonnage now owned in the world, excluding vessels of less than 100 tons (gross for steam and net for sail amounts to 41,915,000 tons. This being the twenty-fifth year of publication of these tables, it may be interesting to compare the present position of the shipping industry with that which it occupied in 1886, when the tables were first compiled.

The following figures, which have been extracted by the Shipping Gazette from the various tables in the 1886, 1900 and 1910 editions of Lloyd's Register Book, show in graphic way the great changes which have occurred during the last quarter of a century.

The first table, for instance, shows the great increase in steam tonnage and the decrease in sailing tonnage which has taken place in the period referred to:

The foregoing table includes all vessels of 100 tons and above recorded in the register book. It appears from the figures which it gives that the tonnage of United Kingdom steamers in 1910 is 172 per cent. greater than in 1886 and that the sailing tonnage has been reduced since that time by 77 per cent. Similarly, the total steam tonnage owned in the British colonies and foreign countries has increased by no less than 307 per cent, while the sailing tonnage has been reduced by 51 per cent. These percentages, however, do not represent quite correctly the relative increase in the carrying power of the fleets of the world. A comparison of potential tonnage of the United Kingdom with that of the rest of the world shows a somewhat different result, as will be seen in the following:
