The steamer Metagama arrived in port Saturday night on her second trip of the season from Liverpool. She carired 136 first and 194 second class passengers. Dr. S. H. Calnek, Miss H. A widowed mother survives him. Aside from this accident the voyage was uneventful.

The Olwen put out from Torreveija, Spain, for St. John's with a cargo of salt on October 20. Fine weather was experienced until November 4 when a storm came up.
