Plantes Vénéneuses

Il y a des aliments que certaines personnes ne peuvent pas supporter et il en est de même également pour les animaux. C'est un fait que certaines plantes qui empoisonnent les chevaux ne font aucun mal aux vaches ou aux moutons, tandis qu'il y en a d'autres fatales pour les vaches et les moutons et pour les porcs et les chevaux se refusent à manger. Dans le bulletin No. 39, deuxième série, des fermes expérimentales "Principales plantes vénéneuses du Canada" par Miss Faith Eyles, B. A. que l'on peut se procurer gratuitement en s'adressant au bureau des Publications, Ministère de l'Agriculture, Ottawa, il y a une liste de plantes qui sont mauvaises pour les différentes catégories d'animaux. Ce bulletin, qui est préparé pour les propriétaires de troupeaux, fournit des renseignements touchant les plantes vénéneuses et permet au cultivateur de distinguer les espèces les plus nuisibles dans son voisinage afin qu'il puisse éviter de pâquer ses animaux sur les étendues infestées jusqu'à tout danger soit passé. On sait que les cas d'empoisonnement causés par les plantes augmentent tous les ans mais on ignore le nombre d'animaux qui meurent de cette façon, faute de renseignements plus précis, et on attribue beaucoup d'accidents à d'autres causes.
