His control of the ball was remarkable, the total percentage of pitching errors charged up against him being away below the average. In 409 games he passed 932, made oighty wild and woolly heaves and burled the ball in some part of the anatomy of 120 batters, and some of them will never forget or forgive him for the act.

George Edward Waddell holds the world's strike-out record for one season under the present pitching distance. In 1904 he fanned 336 batsman in forty-one games, an average of 5.19 per game. In 1908 he struck
