

17. Every candidate for a degree will be required to prepare and deposit with the Registrar at least once a month before the final examination for graduation a dissertation not less than forty folios in length, on some legal topic selected by himself. The dissertation must be satisfactory as to matter, form and style, and the student presenting it will be examined upon it.

## FEES.

## 18. Payable to the Faculty:—

For enrollment as student, and certificate thereof, - -	\$ 1 00
For each annual examination, - - - - -	2 00
For application for degree, including examination on dissertation, etc., - - - - -	4 00
Fee for degree, payable to the University, - - - -	25 00

## GENERAL PROVISIONS, ETC.

19. All details of the School not provided for by these rules will be settled by the Faculty, or by that member of the Faculty having exclusive control of the detail as occasion may require.

20. These rules shall not be amended or altered to the prejudice of students who have acted upon the faith thereof.

21. Additional and further rules may be made from time to time to carry out the objects of the School.
