

## In Memoriam.

### WILLIAM M. BROWN,

*Past Grand Worthy Patriarch,*

**A Member of Chebucto Division, No. 7.**

Brother Brown was born in the City of Halifax, January 21, 1811; joined the Order February 4, 1848, as a charter member of Chebucto Division, No. 7, of which Division he was the first Worthy Patriarch; was initiated into the Grand Division in April, 1849; was elected Grand Worthy Patriarch in October, 1851, and took his seat in the National Division in June, 1860.

He died in the City of Halifax on the 27th May, 1888, aged 77 years.
