For eleven years held the office of Deputy Reeve, and is now Reeve of the Tp. of Emily. Is also Lt. Col. Victoria Reserve Militia. Has been long connected with the Orange body, and for some years held the office of County Master. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at g. e. 1874; re-elected at last g. e. MCRORY, JOHN, J. P. (*Addington*)

Second s. of Matthew T. McRory, who emigrated to Canada from Ireland in 1823. B. in Kingston Tp., 1834. Ed. at Kingston. M. at Kingston, Dec. 1856, Miriam, dau. of Abraham Wood, Esq. Filled the office of Reeve from 1865 to 1877, and was Warden Co. Frontenac for the year 1876. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. A Conservative, and believes the readjustment of the tariff will be an advantage to the country.—*Loughborough, Ont.*

MERNER, SAMUEL. (*South-Waterloo.*)

S. of Jacob Merner, farmer, of Canton Berne, Switzerland. B. at Canton Berne, Switzerland, 29 Jan. 1823. Ed. at same place. M. in Preston, Ont., Nov. 1845, to Mary Ann Grasser, dau. of Joseph Grasser, farmer, of Wilmet Tp., Co. Waterloo. Was Warden of the Co. of Waterloo in 1873, and Reeve of the Village of New Hamburg for the last seven years. For a number of years all Swiss people emigrating to the Western Prov. have been directed to Mr. Merner. Contested the Riding in 1877, on the death of John Fleming, Esq., M. P. P., for the Local Legislature, with Isaac Masters, Esq., when he was defeated by 23 votes. Returned to House of Commons at last g. e. An Independent, but in favour of the National Policy.—*New Hamburg, Ont.*
