B. at Yarmouth, 31 Jan., 1844, and ed. there. Graduated at the Philadelphia Coll. of Dental Surgery, in 1866. M., 26 May, 1869, Annie M., dau. of Bennett Smith, Esq., of Windsor, N.S. ; she d. 1880. Is a shipowner, insurance agent and broker, Secretary of the Shipowners Marine Insurance Co., Presdt. Pidgeon Fertilizer Co., Dir. N.S. Telephone Co., and of the Halifax Tram. Co. Has been Probate Registrar of Hants Co., and a mem. of the Town Council and Warden of Windsor. Sat in the House of Assem. for N.S. from 1882, to June, 1896, when he resigned and was elected to Parlt. for present seat at g. e., 1896. A Liberal.—*Windsor, N.S.*

Fifth s. of the late Hon. Robert Unwin Harwood, a native of Sheffield, Eng., who represented the Rigaud division, in the Leg. Council of Canada, until his death, in 1863—by dau. of the late Hon. Alain Chartier de Lotbiniere, Seigneur of Vaudreuil, de Lotbiniere and Rigaud, and grand-daughter of the Marquis de Lotbiniere. B. in Vaudreuil, 8 Aug., 1840. Ed. at St. Mary's Coll., Montreal. M., 17 May, 1864, Josephine Sidney, dau. of the late J. C. Brauneis, Esq. Is a Provincial Land Surveyor. First returned to Parlt. at g. e., 1891 ; unseated, and re-elected 1893. Re-elected at g. e., 1896. A Liberal.—*Vaudreuil*.

HENDERSON, DAVID (*Hallon*).
