An Act to provide for the incorporation and better management of Library Associations and Mechanics' Institutes.

WHEREAS it is expedient to encourage the es- Freamble. tablishment of Library Associations and Mechanics' Institutes, and for that purpose to provide for the incorporation of such Institutions, and to grant them certain 5 powers enabling them better to protect their property and manage their affairs: Be it it therefore enacted, &c.

Mechanics' Institute or both (as the case may be) at some place to be named in such declaration, in which they shall also state, the corporate name of the Institution, —its pur-15 pose,—the amount of money or moneys' worth subscribed by them respectively or held by them for the use there of, —the names of those who are to be the first Trustees for managing its affairs, and the mode in which their successors are to be appointed, or new members of the corpo-20 ration admitted, or in which By-laws are to be made for such appointment or admission, or for any other purpose or for all purposes, and generally such other particulars and provisions as they may think necessary, not being contrary to this Act or to law; and one dupli- Declaration to

25 cate of such declaration shall then be fyled in the office be fyled, &c.

of the Registrar of deeds for the County, by one of the subscribing parties, who shall before such Registrar acknowledge the execution thereof by himself and declare the same to have been executed by the other parties 30 thereto, either in person or by their attorneys; and the Registrar shall then keep one of the said duplicates and deliver the other to the person fyling the same, with a certificate of the same having been so fyled and the execution attested before him; and such duplicate 35 or any copy thereof certified by such Registrar, shall be prima facie evidence of the facts alleged in such declaration and certificate.

II. And be it enacted. That when the formalities afore-Institution said have been complied with, the persons having signed incorporated. 40 such declaration as aforesaid, and their successors shall be a body corporate and politic, and shall have the powers,
