BILL.

An Act to authorize the Ursuline Nuns of Quebec to acquire and hold additional Real and Personal Property to a certain amount.

WHEREAS the Superior, the Assistant, and Preamble.

other professed Nuns of the Convent of the Ursuline Nuns of Quebec, forming the Council of the said Convent, have by their petition prayed that they may be empowered to acquire and hold property to a certain amount over and above that which they now possess; and whereas, by reason of the great usefulness of the said institution, it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall be lawful to and for the said Superior, Assistant, and other pro-15 fessed Nuns forming the Council of the said Convent, and their successors in office, to acquire and receive by donation, devise, bequest, or otherwise, and to hold for the use of the said Convent, by the name of "the Ursuline 20 " Nuns of Quebec," and according to the Rules and By-laws of that Institution, any kind of real property whatever lying within this Province, or any annual constituted rents (rentes constituées,) or ground rents (rentes 25 foncières) secured upon any such property, or any sums of money in the public funds of the United Kingdom, or secured by debentures on the public revenue of this Province, or any other species of property whatsoever, produc-30 ing in the whole a fixed and permanent income not exceeding two thousand pounds currency per annum, over and above all property legally
